Enhancing Rural Disaster Resilience through Effective Infrastructure Investment

Purpose of the project

- Promoting quality infrastructure investment to enhance disaster resilience in the APEC region, in particular, in rural and non-metropolitan areas.
- Focuses particularly on "Rehabilitation and Build Back Better (BBB)", as well as on prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, defined in the APEC DRR Framework.

Backgrounds:

- This APEC Framework cuts across all areas of the APEC agenda, including agriculture; forestry; fisheries; trade and investments; energy; micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs); infrastructure development; critical infrastructure resiliency; financial resiliency; human capital; health; gender; food security; science and technology; and ecological integrity.
- "Sendai Framework: Priority 4: Enhancing disaster preparedness for effective response and to "Build Back Better" in recovery, rehabilitation and reconstruction it is important, to promote the resilience of new and existing critical infrastructure, including water, transportation and telecommunications infrastructure, educational facilities, hospitals and other health facilities--

- Organising workshop in Vinh in September, back to back SDMOF September, 2017, Vinh
- Compiling a case book for promoting effective and resilient infrastructure investment
