Global Challenge


At present time, our world is beset by global changes and a pandemic both unseen in a century, compounded by increasing climate emergency, extreme weathers and many other non-traditional safety hazards, the world economy is facing headwinds and global vulnerability and inequality has been further deepened. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development has confronted daunting challenges.

Nature disaster in China

China is one of the most disaster-prone countries in the world with high frequency and severity, nature disaster risks and accidents are interwined and formed systemic and cascading hazards which pose severe and complicated challenges for effective disaster prevention, reduction and relief.

MEM

on 16th April 2018, the Ministry of Emergency Management of P.R.China (MEM) has been officially established based on the integration of 13 mandates formerly belonged to 11 government agencies and responsibilities from 5 National Command and Coordination Headquarters. More than 200000 firefighters were transferred into the Ministry, the National Comprehensive Firefighting Team was built.




Cooperation with APEC EPWG

- China has been playing active role in all activities of EPWG to contribute inputs into the development of our working group.
- Firstly, we have been Co-chair of EPWG for two times, which shows our strong commitment and engagement in EPWG capacity-building;
- Secondly, in 2021 guided and steered by China's Co-chair, EPWG formulated <<2021-2024 EPWG Strategic Plan>>, which integrated advanced concept into disaster reduction effort, transforming the focus from disaster relief to disaster prevention, from single disaster to systemic disasters, applying scientific technologies, MSE disaster resilience building and others. If it is endorsed, it will be the guiding document for EPWG in 4 years ahead.
- Thirdly, we actively applied for projects founded by APEC and our own economy.
- since 2020 we have conducted 4 projects:Regional Economic Integration through the lens of disaster resilience; Recovery and resilience:Risk-smart Business for SMEs in the Post Covid-19;Workplace safety Management in work resumption under Covid-19;Rural Community disaster resilience capacity building.

On 3 November 2021, we hosted the Belt and Road Ministerial Forum for International Cooperation in Disaster Risk Reduction and Emergency Management, marking the official launch of the framework, which was included into Belt and Road Forum for international Cooperation. The framework aims to optimize international cooperation resources and achievements, comprehensively plan the regional cooperation development, advance the exchange and cooperation with the Belt and Road countries, better facilitate domestic emergency management undertakings, build a community of shared future for mankind and implement Global Development Initiative.

- (1) Research on international disaster reduction strategy and policy;**


